DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NOVA SURF is a water soluble surface – active agent designed for use in certain agricultural sprays.

Herbicides: Add 2 to 4 pints of NOVA SURF per 100 gallons of spray mixture. NOVA SURF should be the last ingredient added to the spray mixture.

Insecticides: Use 4 to 8 ounces of NOVA SURF per 100 gallons of spray mixture.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
